 - ✂ He thanked Will Butler for all his efforts on Saturday's in ensuring w mostly fielded full sides. He commented that Sunday games were well supported throughout the season.
 - ✂ Overall there was a disappointing lack of support for fundraising events despite the great efforts made by Tania and Nicole to organise these functions.
 - ✂ Thanks to Jim Collins organisation and good support from players the tour proved successful.
 - ✂ He thanked Robert Knight for all his efforts in producing good wickets despite a very dry summer.
 - ✂ The pavilion, especially replacement of thatch and interior improvements remained the main cause for concern going into 2011.

COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS

 - ✂ Tim Jenkins reiterated the need to ensure that the pavilion thatch is the number one priority for the coming season and that any fundraising events reflect this need. The club needs to continue to seek grant aid, and also speak to the Parish Council in this regard.
